FORD FUSION NAMED 2013 "GREEN CAR OF THE YEAR"

The Ford Fusion became the least expensive vehicle to ever when this award. In the past, sales of green vehicles have been hampered by their relatively high price tags.

The Fusion, which starts at \$21,700 for the gas-powered base model, won because it is offered in a wide range of powertrains, said Ron Cogan, editor of Green Car Journal, which gives out the annual award to recognize leadership in cutting emissions.

"It won by virtue of the fact that it offers an array of choices," Cogan said after announcing the award during the LA Auto Show on Thursday."This is huge."

Ford offers the Fusion gas-powered, hybrid and plug-in hybrid models. The Fusion hybrid is estimated to get 47 miles per gallon. A hybrid is an automobile with more than one power source, such as an electric motor and internal combustion engine or an electric motor with battery and fuel cells for energy storage. In the past, sales of green vehicles have been hampered by their relatively high price tags.

The Fusion, which starts at \$21,700 for the gas-powered base model, won because it is offered in a wide range of powertrains, said Ron Cogan, editor of Green Car Journal, which gives out the annual award to recognize leadership in cutting emissions.

"It won by virtue of the fact that it offers an array of choices," Cogan said after announcing the award during the LA Auto Show on Thursday."This is huge.

Ford spokesperson Wes Sherwood said the company was expecting to see a wider range for fuel economy on its new generation of hybrids because it is not asking drivers to compromise on vehicle performance. "If you want to drive for maximum fuel economy, the car has the tools. You can do it," Sherwood said.

SOMETIMES OVERLOOKED...BUT NOT FORGOTTEN

Natchez City Cemetery Offers Interesting Historical Timelines

A tour of the Natchez City Cemetery is a glimpse back in time to the early days of historic Natchez, revealing the rich and colorful tapestry of this early Southern city on the Mississippi River. Many of the builders of the magnificent Natchez antebellum homes are buried here.

Located on Cemetery Road, and overlooking the Mississippi River, the Natchez City Cemetery was established in 1822 and covers approximately 100 acres of land.

The old burying ground was on a high hill where Memorial Park and St. Mary's Cathedral are located in downtown Natchez. Samuel Brooks, the first Mayor of Natchez, from 1803-1811, is still buried there. When the cemetery was established in its present location, the remains from the old burial ground were gradually moved to the present site north of the town.

Markers with dates of deaths in the late 1700's testify to the fact that the remains were also moved from churchyards and private plantation burial grounds. Romantic, tragic and mysterious tales lie buried in the old graves.

Numerous beautiful, creatively designed iron fences, benches, iron mausoleum doors, tombstones and monuments are found within the cemetery. The varied patterns of ironwork represent almost the entire spectrum of ironwork produced in America in the 19th and early 20th Centuries. Artistically sculptured markers with often-poignant inscriptions add to the unique character of the burial ground.

The majority of the signed marble work dates to before the Civil War. Edwin Lyon and Robert Rawes, two of the most prolific and outstanding antebellum marble workers can be credited with many of the beautifully sculpted monuments. There were numbers of other talented artisans whose work contributes to the beauty of the cemetery.

RECIPE Husband's Delight

A hearty stew can sure hit the spot on a blustery day. This recipe offers lots of fun, hands-on work for a houseful of cooks. And because beef stew is meant to cook slowly, kids will discover the merit of having a little patience.

What you'll need

INGREDIENTS:

10 ounces egg noodles 1 1/2 pounds ground beef 1 (14.5 ounce) can peeled and diced tomatoes with juice 1 teaspoon salt 1 tablespoon white sugar 1 1/2 cups sour cream 3 ounces cream cheese 1/2 onion, chopped 1 cup shredded Cheddar cheese

How to make it

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).

2. Bring a large pot of lightly salted water to a boil. Add pasta and cook for 8 to 10 minutes or until al dente; drain.

3. In a large skillet over medium heat, brown the ground beef. Add the tomatoes with juice, salt and sugar and simmer for 15 minutes.

4. In a separate medium bowl, combine the sour cream, cream cheese and onion and mix well. In a 9x13 inch baking dish, place half of the egg noodles, then all of the meat mixture, then the cream mixture. Top with the remaining noodles and sprinkle with the cheese.

5. Bake at 350 degrees F (175 degrees C) for 25 minutes.
